



Cupcake Pincushion Project

Supplies: Fleece Pins
Needle Fiberfill
Thread Scissors
Button Silicone Cupcake Liner

Instructions:

1. Cut a circle out of fleece (approximately 4" in diameter).
2. Attach a red button to the center of the circle.
3. With your threaded needle, puncture a hole into the bottom of the silicone cupcake liner from the outside. Do not cut thread.
4. Stitch around the perimeter of the fleece circle with a straight stitch. When you reach the point where you started, gently tug on the thread like a drawstring to tighten it and form a pouch.
5. Place a wad of Fiberfill into the pouch.
6. Tighten the thread so the pouch is closed.
7. Stitch back and forth through the ends of the circle to close the pouch.
8. Poke needle (still connected!) into the bottom inside of cupcake liner.
9. Gently tighten the thread until pouch sits securely inside cupcake liner with red button centered on top like a cherry.
10. Using fingers, manipulate the cupcake until it is positioned to your liking.
11. Tighten threads from outside bottom of cupcake liner and knot together.
12. Cut thread.
13. Place sticker on bottom of cupcake liner to cover knots.
14. Insert pins into cupcake as sprinkles.
